Members are advised that the NSW State Government have announced that after assessing the new framework from the National Cabinet last Friday, COVID-19 restrictions will start to ease across NSW from next Friday 15 May 2020.

The easing of these restrictions are designed to allow more businesses to open and more people to stay in work. However, members should note that restrictions are intended to be eased on a gradual, stepped basis.
